Desford Swim Code of Conduct

All members and guests of Desford Swim will;

- Respect the rights and dignity of every person within the club.
- Treat everyone equally and not discriminate on any grounds.
- Not condone or allow unchallenged any form of discrimination.
- Promote the positive aspects and activities of the club.
- Ensure wellbeing and safety of children within the club.
- Be aware of the clubs Safe Guarding policy.
- Report any concerns to a member of the committee or the Welfare Officer.

Data protection and social media and Safe Guarding

Data Protection

We only keep information regarding members that allows us to communicate with said member.

When a member leaves the club for whatever reason their personal information will be destroyed.

Social Media

Any member using club's social media platforms inappropriately will be bringing the club into disrepute and will consequently have their membership withdrawn.

Safe Guarding

Desford swim will follow the British Naturism safe guarding policy for both children and adults. Desford swim will appoint a Welfare Officer.

Swimming pool and sports hall safety and hygiene.

- No Smoking or Vaping is allowed anywhere in the premises.
- Alcohol or recreational drugs are not allowed on the premises.
- Anyone believed to have consumed alcohol or recreational drugs prior to visiting the club will be asked to leave.
- Please remember to always sit on a towel.
- If space allows please leave clothes and sports bags in the changing room.
- Children must be accompanied and supervised by a person of 18 years or over at all times.
- All forms of rough play and inappropriate physical contact are prohibited.

Swimming pool

- Members and visitors must obey the instructions of the life guard at all times.
- Members and visitors are requested to shower before entering the pool.
- Members and visitors must observe the normal swimming pool rules.
- No one must enter the pool side or water if a lifeguard is not present on the poolside.
- No diving at the shallow end and where water depth is less than 1.5m.
- Children who are not toilet trained or under 2 years of age must wear swim nappies.
- Anybody suffering from diarrhoea or unusually loose bowel movements, should not use the pool for at least 2 days after symptoms have cleared.

Sport Hall

- Appropriate footwear is advised.
- Adults must be able to use the equipment safely.

Desford Swim Photography Policy

- Members and visitors do not have permission to take photographs or moving images on any device within Desford swim.
- However, Desford Swim committee can authorise an individual to take
 photographs for special reasons i.e. publicity for approved BN magazines. The
 consent of any person included in images taken must be sort.
- All members and visitors have an expectation that their privacy will be respected.
- Smart glasses are not permitted at any Desford Swim event.
